

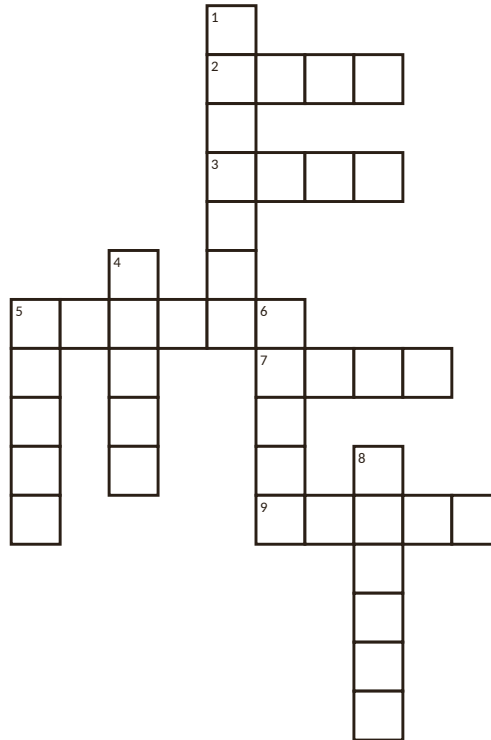

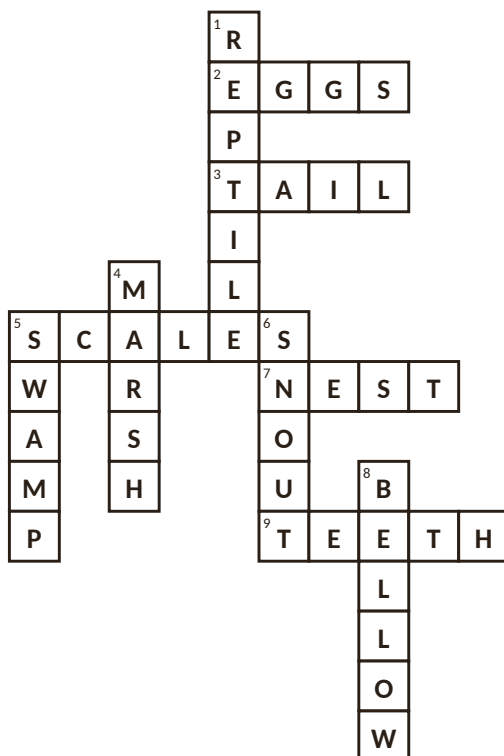
ACROSS
